The department was established during the year 2015-2016. The Under graduate course offered by the department is B.Voc in Textiles and Apparel Design which gives an in-depth knowledge of Apparel merchandising, fashion designing, Basics of textiles, Industrial Engineering, Sewing Machine Operator, Production Supervisor, Draping, Garment Construction, Textile Analysis, Textile Processing, Sourcing Manager and computer application in designing. The Programme is aimed with the following objectives.

- To Upgrade skills to international standards through significant industry involvement
- To develop necessary frameworks for standards, curriculum and quality assurance in the Apparel Sector.
- To Enhance, support and coordinate initiatives for skill development through appropriate Apparel sector
- Effective assessment testing and credible certification of formally /informally acquired skills of Sewing Machine Operator, Production Supervisor, Industrial Engineering and Sourcing Manager Levels
- To promote Self Employment

Duration of the Programme

The three-year under graduate program in B.Voc Textiles and Apparel Design consists of six semesters under Choice Based Credit System with NOS/QP packs approved by the Sector Skill Council.

Eligibility for Admission

A Pass 10+3 Years Diploma, A Pass in Higher Secondary Examination (Academic or Vocational Stream) conducted by the Government of any state. No age Limit.

Teaching Methodologies

The teaching method will be "Student Centered approach" with traditional and modern approach like On the Job Training, Internship, field trip and demonstration.

Examinations

Semester pattern is followed. The examination for the Semester I, III and V will be held in November/December and for Semester II, IV and VI will be in the month of April/May. NSDC Assessment will be held on the Sewing Machine Operator, Production Supervisor, Industrial Engineering and Sourcing Manager Levels followed by NOS.

Scheme for valuation

Evaluation will be done on a continuous basis and will be evaluated four times during the course work. The first evaluation will be in the 7th week, the second in the 11th week, third in the 16th week and the end – semester examination in the 19th week. Evaluation may be by objective type questions, short answers, essays or a combination of these, but the end semester examination is a university theory examination with prescribed question paper pattern.
