Periyar University

Therefore, the need of the hour is to devise ways and means to strengthen the teacher education system in the country.

In the recent past, the Government of India has taken many efforts to enhance the quality of teacher education. Even though the government is taking necessary initiatives to enhance the quality of teacher education, the curricula still remain fairly heavy, repetitive and burdensome. The issues related to practice teaching, internship and engagement with the field still persist. These current issues and challenges need to be addressed to ensure the quality of teacher education in the country. Hence, this is the right time to call upon practicing teacher educators, teachers, educational administrators,

educational researchers and policy makers to debate, discuss and bring diverse opinion together on a common platform to devise innovative strategies to resolve the current issues and challenges in the domain of teacher education.

Guidelines for Full Paper Submission

- ❖ The paper should be written in English and typed in MS Word using Times New Roman with 12 font size and 1.5 line spacing.
- ❖ The length of full paper including tables, graphs, references etc. should not exceed 8 pages (A4 size) and in a single file containing cover page, abstract, text, graphs etc.
- ❖ References should be alphabetically arranged and the APA style manual (6th Edition) should be followed for references and citation.
- ❖ The final version of the full paper (soft copy) should be sent through e-mail to pudoeseminar2018@gmail.com by 25th September, 2018
- ❖ Besides, please send a hard copy of the paper along with filled-in registration form to the Organising Secretary within stipulated deadline.
- ❖ Submission of the full paper signifies that the participant agrees to seminar participation and Copyright Agreement.
- ❖ The expert committee will review all the submitted full papers and acceptance of the same will be communicated to the author(s) subsequently. The selected papers will be published as an Edited Book by the reputed national publisher with ISBN.
