Out of the total grant sanctioned under the Non-recurring Head Rs.23,92,355/- has been spent and the balance amount Rs.36,07,355/- has to be spent within the year end.

In accordance with the Tamil Nadu Government (Salary) G.O.No.392, based on the resolution of the Syndicate meeting of Periyar University dated on 20.11.2009, limited tenders were invited from the following 10 firms.

- 1) M/s SAS Bakery Kitchen Equipments, Bangalore
- 2) M/s Chandran Steels, Coimbatore
- 3) M/s The Precision Scientific Company, Coimbatore
- 4) M/s Global Kitchen Equipments Company, Coimbatore
- 5) M/s Venus Engineers, Coimbatore
- 6) M/s Genuine Manufacturers, Coimbatore
- 7) M/s J K Equipment Company, Coimbatore
- 8) M/s Rusira Modern Kitchen Equipments, Coimbatore
- 9) M/s Arun Rega Bakery Machineries Pvt Ltd, Coimbatore

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10) M/s Thermodyn Bakery & Industrial Equipments Pvt Ltd, Bangalore

In response to the tender notice, only 3 firms submitted their filled in tenders with EMD. Amongst M/S The Precision Scientific Company, Coimbatore has submitted the lowest quote of Rs.7,05,925/- (Including Taxes) to supply the said bakery equipment.

The purchase committee of Periyar University held on 30.05.2017 unanimously resolved to procure the equipment from the L1 vendor. The minutes of the item 2 of Purchase Committee reads thus:

"Based on the purchase committee negotiation with the company representative, they were ready to reduce 4% of the total quoted price and hence recommends for the approval of the Syndicate to purchase the item from L1 vendor (M/s The Precision Scientific Company, Coimbatore)."

Based on the above resolution, the aforementioned company agreed to give a 4% discount and confirmed the same through their letter. Therefore, after discount of 4%, the Bakery equipment cost stood at Rs.6,77,688/- (including taxes).

The Syndicate held on 12.06.2017 resolved, the following:

"Deferred. Project-wise details like date of grant, requirements etc. and the justification of purchase are yet to be provided. Specifications in the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998" are to be strictly followed.

In this connection, Professor T. Poongodi Vijayakumar, Food Science and Nutrition Department stressed the need for the equipment for their B.Voc. programme and also provided reasons and justifications for the deferred resolution and requested for the same to be reconsidered and granted permission.

Moreover, M/ s The Precision Scientific Company, Coimbatore which had quoted the lowest amount has agreed to supply the equipment at the previously quoted price of Rs. 6,77,688/- even amidst the GST regulations through their letter.

It is further stated that quoting the Tamil Nadu Transparency Tender Act, 1998 and Rules 2000 and as per the Periyar University circular (2), the current purchase falls under the purview of limited tenders.

Therefore, the purchase of Bakery equipment for Food Science and Nutrition Department of Periyar university for their B.Voc. Programme, through the limited tender basis from L1 vendor M/ s The Precision Scientific Company, Coimbatore for Rs.6,77,688/- (inclusive of taxes) may be considered. This matter is resubmitted to the Syndicate for approval.
