Participants should bring their requirements.
Duration - 1 hour

Modern Art- Rangoli

Topics – Theatre, Settings, Depiction of any scenes, Characters from Shakespeare's plays.
Participants should bring their requirements.
One group with three participants per college.
Duration – 1 hour

Face Painting

Themes – Peace, Love, Villainy, Comedy, Tragedy- Shakespeare's Plays.
One group with two participants per College.
Participants should bring their requirements.
Duration – 1 hour

Doodle-Spot Drawing

Depicting any scene from Shakespeare's plays. Theme will be given on the Spot. Drawing only in chart.
Participants should bring their requirements.
Painting can be done with oil, water, pencil, poster or pastel colours. Two participants per College.
Duration - 1 hour

Dumb Charades

Based on Shakespeare's plays.
One team with two members per College.

Fashion Parade

a) Solo

The participants should reveal their characters through one dialogue and action.
Two participants per College.

b) Group

- One team per College.
- Five participants per team

- Related to Shakespeare's characters.
- The participants should bring their necessary requirements.
