	<p>Dr.S.Murugesh has joined in Periyar University on 05.04.2013 as Professor in the Department of Botany and his service was regularized on 04.08.2015 after the probation. His date of birth is 03.06.1957. As he attained the age 60, he was relieved from the service on 30.06.2017 based on the minutes of the 96th Syndicate meeting held on 12.06.2017 after getting the no due certificate from him.</p> <p>Further, he has filed a writ petition (W.P.No.16211/2017,</p>															

dt.14.07.2017) for extending his service till 2017-2018 academic year. As the Hon'ble High Court of Madras rejected his writ petition for consideration of his service period till 2017-2018 academic year. As per his letter dated 03.04.2017, he has requested the University to release the CPS, SPLPF, FSF and EL amount. As FBF is only for those died during service, other benefits are eligible to claim by him. Meanwhile, Periyar University Teachers Association (PUTA) has filed a case MP.No.2/2013 and a writ petition (W.P.10585/2013, Dt.18.04.2013) regarding the objections in the appointments of all teaching posts. A reply has been sent for all the clarifications sought by the court and counter affidavit was filed on 20.06.2016. In this case, there is no specific objection for the appointment of Dr.S.Murugesh.

In addition, Dr.C.Alageshaboopathi also filed a writ petition (W.P.No.25735/2017) against the appointment of Dr.S.Murugesh as Professor in Botany. This case is still pending in the Hon.ble High Court of Madras. In the case of appointments, the decision of the selection committee and Syndicate is final. The University advocate is also taking steps to abolish the case by filing the relevant clarification and counter affidavit.

Even though the above two cases are pending in the court, his request may be considered to release the retirement benefits like CPS, EL and UEL on Private Affaires for the period from 05.08.2013 to 30.06.2017 as per the following details furnished in table.

This degree programme will provide the students with the technical skills in Mathematics and Actuarial Science to take up the jobs in various industries. This programme may be offered from the academic year 2019-2020 by the affiliated colleges of Periyar University.</p> <p>ii) B.Com (Financial Marketing Analytics)</p>		

The objectives of B.Com (Financial Marketing Analytics) programme is to impart professional education and training in various aspects of business and its environment and provide them with opportunities to develop analytical skills in order to meet the challenges of business at the National and Global level. The programme aims to sharpen skills in finance and enable to examine financial decisions critically based on strong financial literacy. The programme provides a well balanced toolbox, helping a candidate to combine tools, techniques and professional judgment on cutting edge topics. It provides a mixed pedagogy associating practical cases and experience by providing new dimensions to the finance topics.

The proposed three year full time B.Com (Financial Marketing Analytics) may be offered from the academic year 2019-2020 by the affiliated colleges of Periyar University.

iii) B.Com (Security Marketing Practices)

The proposed programme has potential enough to get employment opportunities from new generation of emerging in the field of stock markets. The ultimate objective of the subject is to acquire the sound knowledge of capital market operation and implications and its significance on Indian economy.

iv) M.Sc. Computer Science (Data Analytics)

Data Analytics is the process of examining data sets in order to draw decisions about the information they contain, increasingly with the aid of specialized systems and software. In this two year Post Graduate M.Sc. Computer Science with Data Analytics programme, the students will be imparted training on Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning Methods to analyse the data with technology. This programme may be offered from the academic year 2019-2020 by the University Department as well as the affiliated colleges of Periyar University.

	The 44 th Finance Committee was held on 18.09.2018, one of the agendas considered was the renovation of Vice Chancellor's

chamber, Syndicate Hall and Registrar's room. It was minuted as deferred till the visit of the Higher Education Secretary to the campus on 29.09.2018.

The chambers of the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and the Syndicate hall of the University do not have structured interiors and aesthetic ambience. The existing structure of Vice Chancellor chamber is 15 year old and Wall paneling is infected and damaged by termites and other insects. The existing Syndicate hall is very congested and cramped which has to be merged with small room adjacent to the syndicate hall. The Registrar chamber is located in a far corner that requires shifting to a central location. These prestigious chambers of the University ought to be modernized with latest facilities. Vice Chancellor's chamber and Registrar's office require mini meeting halls, waiting halls, pantry and rest rooms. Hence, the existing structure warrants renovation and face lifting of basic interiors.

Consequently, 101st Syndicate meeting was held on 29.09.2018 at Periyar University. The Principal Secretary, Higher Education Department attended the meeting and visited the existing Vice Chancellor chamber, Registrar chamber and Syndicate Hall. Then the matter was discussed in the 101st Syndicate meeting and the Syndicate resolved to "re-submit the split ups of the proposal of the proposed work".

As per the recommendation of the Syndicate and the direction of the Principal Secretary, Higher Education Department the proposed estimate cost is considerably reduced and the proposal has been splitted into renovation and re-arrangements of Vice Chancellor Room at the estimated cost of **Rs. 35.50 Lakhs**, renovation and re-arrangements of Registrar room and Syndicate hall at the estimated cost of **Rs. 54.20 Lakhs**. Total Estimate cost for the proposal is **Rs.89.70 lakhs**. It was resubmitted and circulated to the members of the Finance Committee for approval.
