UNIVERSITY PROFILE

The Government of Tamil Nadu established the Periyar University at Salem on 17th September 1997 as per the provisions of the Periyar University Act, 1997. The University covers the area comprising four districts namely Salem, Namakkal, Dharmapuri and Krishnagiri. The University Grants Commission bestowed 12(B) and 2(f) status to the Periyar University. The university bagged 68th rank among Indian Universities by MHRD NIRF 2019.

The University is named after the Great Social Reformer E.V. Ramasamy, affectionally called "Thanthai Periyar". The University aims at developing knowledge in various fields to realize the maxim inscribed in the logo "Arival Vilayum Ulagu" (Wisdom Maketh the World). 'Holistic development of the students' is the primary objective of the esteemed Periyar University.

Periyar University imparts higher education through three modes viz., through its Departments of Study and Research, the Affiliated Colleges and Periyar Institute of Distance Education (PRIDE). The University has 27 departments and 106 affiliated colleges.

The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) was introduced for various programmes offered by the University right from the inception. From 2009-10 onwards the University has been offering certificate courses in order to cater to the current needs of the public. Periyar University provides student support services such as Library, National Service Scheme, Youth Red Cross, Women's Welfare Centre and avenues for sports and games.

Periyar University has a PG Extension Centre at Dharmapuri with 8 Departments. Periyar University has taken the significant step of promoting interdisciplinary study and research.

At present, four departments have SAP, sanctioned by the UGC and Seven departments have FIST programme sanctioned by DST. The departments, Textiles and Apparel Design and Food Science and Nutrition have been granted Rs. 1.5 crores by UGC to run the B.Voc. Programme in the respective disciplines.

The schools, departments, institutes, chairs, centers and cells contribute their best through various academic, research and extension activities. The University is playing a paramount role in bringing multi-faceted development for the country. It is consistently organizing innumerable academic activities to bring academicians and industrialists under one umbrella to discuss, deliberate and carve out time-demanding solutions to social problems.

The University has tie-ups with a number of academic, research institutes and universities across the world to stay up to date on quality benchmarks. Important days at the International and National levels are observed by the University to promote awareness on key issues that impact human life and the mother earth.

STUDENT ADVISER & COURSE REGISTRATION

Every student will have a member of faculty of the department as his/her student adviser. All teachers of the department shall function as Student Advisers and will have more or less equal number of students. The Student Adviser will advise the students in choosing Elective courses and offer all possible student support services. The student will then register for the course he/she plans to take for the semester before the commencement of the classes.

At the end of each course, there will be an assessment of the student through proctored examination and the marks/ grades secured in this exam could be transferred to the academic record of the students.

EXAMINATIONS

There shall be examinations at the end of each semester : for odd semesters in October / November; and for even semesters in April / May.

Evaluation

The performance of a student in each course is evaluated in terms of percentage of marks with a provision for conversion to grade points. Evaluation for each course shall be done by a Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) by the course teacher concerned as well as by an end semester examination and will be consolidated at the end of the semester.

Industrial Course

Industrial course should be offered in second or third semester with one or two credits in every department.

Supportive Paper

Supportive paper should be offered only in second and third semesters. Students are expected to opt Supportive Course (Non major elective) offered by other departments. Students can earn three credit from supportive course.

Swayam Course

SWAYAM is a programme initiated by Government of India and designed to achieve the three cardinal principles of Education Policy namely access, equity, and quality. The objective of this effort is to take the best teaching learning resources to all, including the most disadvantaged. SWAYAM seeks to bridge the digital divide for students who have hitherto remained untouched by the digital revolution and have not been able to join the mainstream of the knowledge economy. The courses hosted on SWAYAM are in 4 quadrants – (1) video lecture, (2) specially prepared reading material that can be downloaded/printed (3) self-assessment tests through tests and quizzes and (4) an online discussion forum for clearing the doubts. Credits

Credit defines the quantum of contents/syllabus prescribed for a course and determine the number of hours of instruction required per week. Thus, normally in each of the courses, credits will be assigned on the basis of the number of lectures/tutorial/ laboratory work and other forms of learning required to complete the course contents in a 15 week schedule:

1 Credit = 1 hour of lecture per week (1Credit course = 15 hours of lectures per semester)

3 Credits = 3 hours of instruction per week (3 Credit course = 45 hours of lectures per semester)

The total minimum credits required for awarding a two year PG Programme is 90, for three year M.C.A., it is 140 and for B.Voc., it is 180.

Project

Each student shall be required to take up an individual student project work at PG level and submit it at the end of the final semester. The Head of the Department shall assign the Guide to the student from all the faculty members in the department. A copy of the Project Report will be submitted to the Department on or before the date fixed by the Department/ University. The Project will be evaluated by an internal examiner and an external examiner nominated by the University.

CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

The Choice Based Credit System is a flexible system of learning. The CBCS was introduced for various programmes offered by the University from 2008-09 onwards. The distinguishing student friendly features of CBCS allow students to:

- ❖ learn at their own pace
- ❖ choose electives from a wide range of elective courses offered by the University departments with consulting department faculty members.
- ❖ adopt inter-disciplinary approach by choosing supportive papers in learning and make best use of the expertise of available faculty.

Departments and Programmes

There are 27 departments offering programmes at various levels under the CBCS. A programme consists of number of courses. A 'Course' is a component (a paper) of a programme. Every course offered by any University department is identified by a unique course code. A course may be designed to involve lectures / tutorials / laboratory work/ seminar / project work / practical training / assignments / industrial training / viva voce, etc. or a combination of these, to meet effectively the teaching and learning needs and the credits may be assigned suitably.

Semesters

An academic year consists of two semesters namely, Odd Semester (I & III Semesters): July to November; and Even Semester (II & IV Semesters): December to April. A semester normally extends over a period of 15 weeks. Each week has 30 hour instruction spread over a 5 day week. The duration of each semester shall be 90 working days for all PG Programme and 120 working days for B.Voc., Programme inclusive of examinations.
