as around 60% of the world population depends upon plants for their basic health care like spinach leaves has vital role in maintaining the body metabolism, quinine from Cinchona for curing malaria, morphine from poppy



plants which is used as pain relief. Further, he insisted about 70% of the anticancer drugs are from tropical rain forest according to National Cancer Institute data. However, according to the World Resources Institute report 100 species die due to tropical deforestation and also estimated that one half

of all the plants and animal species will face extinction by 2050 due to global warming and melting of ice glaciers in polar regions may submerge the port cities like Tokyo, London and Kolkata.



**Dr. P.A. Azeez**, Director, Salim Ali Centre for Ornithology and Natural History (SACON), Coimbatore delivered keynote address in the event. He emphasized

nearly 40% of the economy of our country is dependent upon the biodiversity products and the values of our biodiversity is unexplained completely. Most of the pharma

companies are keen to our biodiversity products for



bioprospecting. Although several medicinal plants has been identified, the active compounds of their plants should cure various diseases is not completely explored.

Hence, the young minds should involve exploring these unknown resources and their values in an effective research in the field of biodiversity, sustainable



management and bioproducts.
