POLICY FOR

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ATTEND SEMINARS / CONFERENCES / SYMPOSIA / PRESENTATION OF RESEARCH PROPOSALS / OTHER ACADEMIC ENDEAVOURS

About the Policy:

The University frames a policy of providing financial assistance to support expenditures incurred by the members of faculty who perform academic/research related activities as defined in the following sections of this policy. This policy comes into effect from 1st April 2018.

Preamble:

The University encourage the member of faculty to attend and participate in Conferences, Symposia, Workshops, Seminars and Training Programmes held in India and abroad for sharing knowledge, academic growth and also for collaborations that would facilitate healthy academic and research ambience. Keeping in view financial assistance upto 50% for travel grant will be provided under the following circumstances.

- To attend conferences/seminars/symposia/workshops, etc. as Chairperson/ Resource Person/Keynote Speaker /Invited Speaker, etc. conducted in India or abroad.
- To attend and present their research papers as first author only in conferences/seminars/symposia/ workshops, etc. conducted in India or abroad.
- To present their research proposals submitted to funding agencies in India/abroad.
- To make any Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) related presentations (patent, copyrights, etc.) in India/abroad.
- To demonstrate new inventions, business models, product prototypes/ models in meetings, seminar, conferences, and symposia conducted in India/abroad.

The financial assistance shall be admissible to the members of faculty who fulfill the following conditions.

1. Provided that the member of faculty has obtained prior approval in writing from the Registrar, Periyar University, Salem.
2. Provided that a copy of the research paper, project proposal or any other relevant document (for IPR, product prototype, business models, etc.) is submitted to the IQAC at the time of making a request for financial assistance.
3. Provided that the member of faculty submits all the necessary bills related to such expenditures to the Finance Office through proper channel.
4. In all circumstances the decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final.
