பெரியார் பல்கலைக்கழத்தின் இணைவு இரத்து/விலகல் கொள்கை (Periyar University De-affiliation Policy)

I- Normal Procedure for De-affiliation:

- a. The affiliated College should submit a request letter for De-Affiliation of their college to University through the College Committee/Trust with the signature of all members.
- b. At the time of submitting the request letter for De-Affiliation, the college should clear all financial dues to the students, University and all the employees of the college.
- c. Further, the relieving orders of all the employees must be submitted.
- d. None of the students should be affected at the time of applying De-Affiliation for the affiliated colleges of Periyar University.
- e. If the affiliated college is willing to apply for De-affiliation, then the accrued interest for the Endowment fee which was paid during college affiliation should be indemnified to the University.
- f. As the endowment fee is deposited with the name of both the college and Periyar University, the said endowment amount will be equally shared by both the college and the University. This will be effected after the document requested for point (b) and (c) as above.
- g. After getting De-Affiliation, from Periyar University the College should take responsibility to obtain G.O. from Government of Tamil Nadu.

II. Procedure for De-affiliation on complaints and unwarranted behavior of the college Management:

- a. An enquiry committee shall be formed with the approval of the Vice Chancellor consisting of at least five members (Two from Syndicate and Three from University Professors).
- b. The enquiry committee's report shall be placed before the Affiliation Committee and its recommendation shall be obtained.
- c. If the Affiliation Committee recommends the de-affiliation of concerned college, then the same may be placed before the Syndicate for approval.
- d. Under these circumstances, the students, if any who have not completed the course shall be accommodated in other colleges without affecting their studies.
- e. The entire endowment fee shall be remitted to the University account
