4.	The HEI portal on the NAAC website is now open for the submission of AQAR 2022-23. No specific deadline has been announced by the NAAC for this submission. Based on the approval granted by the committee in the previous meeting (12th May 2023), the IQAC has commenced the process of gathering data from the University departments, centers, cells, and offices through		

circulars dated 26th June 2023 and 17th August 2023. The IQAC intends to complete the data collection by or before 12th September 2023. Subsequently, the IQAC aims to finalize the compilation and submit the AQAR 2022-23 on or before 29th September 2023.

Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)

Following NAAC guidelines, a committee comprising external members was formed by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor for the preparation of the AAA proforma, which convened on 12th June 2023. Following this session, another committee consisting of internal members was constituted by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor to finalize the AAA proforma. This internal committee held meetings on 4th August 2023, 10th August 2023, and 25th August 2023 and finalised the AAA proforma. Copy of the finalised proforma is attached.

Utilizing this AAA proforma, the IQAC plans to conduct the AAA involving external peers (experts) in the final week of September 2023.

NAAC (Margadarshan) Mentor-Mentee Scheme

NAAC has introduced a new scheme named "Margadarshan" to encourage all Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) aspiring for accreditation to join the accreditation process through mentoring. Under this scheme, Periyar University signed separate MoUs with 6 affiliated colleges (Mentee institutions) on 20th January 2023. NAAC specifies that the duration of the Mentor-Mentee Scheme is 3 months. Considering the progress achieved, the IQAC requested a 3-month extension from NAAC after obtaining approval from this committee in the preceding meeting (12th May 2023).

In the meantime, one of the mentee institutions, namely Shri Sakthikailassh Women's College, Salem, submitted its Self-Study Report (SSR) on 28th July 2023.

On 22nd August 2023, NAAC responded, inquiring about the time required to ensure that all the mentee institutions submit their SSRs. Based on the advancements made by other mentee institutions, the IQAC aims to finalize this process by the conclusion of the current academic year (May 2024). The IQAC seeks approval to communicate this timeline to NAAC.

Organising FDP/ATP/EDP

IQAC, in collaboration with University departments/centres/cells, organized 4 Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) and 2 Academic Training Programs (ATPs) from January 2023 to March 2023. Based on the approval granted by this committee during the previous meeting (12th May 2023), this scheme was extended to the current academic year (2023-24). In light of this, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor advised IQAC to ensure that the programs are distributed evenly across the academic year. Accordingly, the IQAC requested proposals from University departments for conducting the aforementioned programs (Circulars dated 11th July 2023, 8th August 2023). In connection with this, the IQAC has received proposals from the following departments:

Application for FICCI Award

The Federation of Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) has

invited applications for the 9th edition of the FICCI Higher Education Excellence (HEE) Awards. The deadline for submitting applications for the aforementioned award is 10th September 2023. The awards are divided into five categories. The IQAC intends to apply for the Excellence in Research, Innovation & Entrepreneurship Award. Application for NAAC Sponsored Seminar The NAAC provides financial assistance to academic institutions, which are having valid accreditation by NAAC to organize state and national level workshop/seminar /conference on themes related to quality issues in Higher Education. The programme is expected to facilitate high standards in higher education in relation to any of the quality parameters in Higher Education. The financial support from NAAC would be partial funding to a maximum of Rs. 1,00,000/- to an HEI to conduct a state/ national level seminar. The financial 10. assistance to an institution will be provided only once in an accreditation cycle. Institutions who wish to avail financial assistance under this scheme should submit their proposal in the prescribed proforma at least five to six months before the proposed date of the seminar to the NAAC. In this context, IQAC plans to apply for financial assistance during the first week of September 2023 and intends to conduct the aforementioned seminar during the third week of February 2024. Conducting a sensitization programme on NAAC Accreditation
