
Placement Day

Special Lecture on G20





The Department of Economics conducted a special lecture programme about G20 on 04.05.2023.

Dr. K. Jayaraman, Professor and Head of the Department delivered the welcome address. Inaugurating the event, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. R. Jagannathan, enlightened the audience about the evolution and role of the G20 in economic cooperation among the member countries. Excerpts from his speech: The G20 alliance is working on economic development and climate change. The development of the countries of the world depends on cooperation between countries, knowledge diffusion, technology sharing, environmental development, and people's progress. The organization was created in 1999 as a result of the Asian economic and financial crisis. The G20 has gone through various stages of development. This year, under the leadership of India, the G20 will work at the global level on trade, sustainable development, health, agriculture, and climate change.



Dr. M. Suresh Babu, an Advisor in the Prime Minister's Economic Advisory Committee and Professor at IIT Chennai, was the special guest and he gave a presentation on Challenges on Financing Resilient Infrastructure. Excerpts from his speech that focused on building strong infrastructure in the present environment: To promote growth among G20 countries, a strong infrastructure should be built through bank lending, bond financing, Public-Private partnership financing, and green bonds. We can achieve faster growth through prioritization of our activities and long-term activities. We must understand India's emerging global power as it is going to chair both the G20 and the Shanghai Summit. India is a country with younger people and is doing well globally. Professors and research students interacted with the economic advisor.

Professor G. Yoganandan, Director of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, delivered the vote of thanks. Professors of the Department of Economics made arrangements for the event. Heads of Departments, Professors, Research Scholars, and Masters Students participated in the event.


