# **About The Seminar**

The seminar focuses on reviewing the Indian government's flagship program, Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), in the context of achieving the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly Goals 3, 5, 6 & 11, which aims to ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all.

The JJM was launched in 2019 by the Government of India, which aims to provide safe and adequate drinking water through individual household tap connections to all rural households by 2024. It focuses on the sustainable management of water resources, including conservation, recharge, and wastewater treatment with the intervention of state and local communities. The seminar would highlight significant milestones achieved under the JJM, such as the number of households that have received piped drinking water. The JJM directly contributes to SDG 6, by promoting access to clean water and sanitation. Additionally, it impacts other SDGs like health & well being (SDG 3), gender equality (SDG 5), and sustainable cities and communities (SDG 11). Hence it is to be discussed how JJM is a crucial part of India's efforts to meet the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

Hence this seminar will focus on the roadmap to achieve 100% rural household coverage by 2024 and ensure long-term sustainability, technological solutions, such as water-efficient practices, smart monitoring systems and community engagement. It will lead to collaboration and partnerships of international co-operations of public-private partnerships, NGOs, and local communities in scaling up the mission and the importance of coordination among various stakeholders to build resilient water infrastructure.

Finally this seminar throws light on the recommendations to address existing challenges, policy reforms, innovations in water resource management, and emphasize the need for sustainable practices to align with the global SDGs.
