IQAC communicated the observation to all the heads of the departments of the University and asked for recommendations from each department separately for each category of stakeholders.

The major recommendations received from the departments are:

- Upgradation of Syllabus
- Encouragement for innovative research.
- Smart Classroom and updated ICT Tools
- Soft skill, Pre-placement training and on-site induction
- Enhancement of Sports, Health care and hostel facilities.

Action Taken by IQAC:

After carefully going through all the recommendations, all the heads of the department were directed to speed-up necessary actions. In relations to the suggestions on syllabus, HODs were directed to place these recommendations in their respective Board of Studies (BoS) meetings for discussion and appropriate decision.

More Soft skill training and on-site induction programmes are to be conducted in every department. Actions have been taken to incorporate medical emergencies and hygiene in all the hostels. The sports and extracurricular activities at the University will be carried out more often on a regular basis by the concerned departments and clubs. The University has decided to provide Internet facilities throughout the campus. It is also planned to upgrade all the classrooms with smart boards and Wi-Fi facilities.




