Internal Quality Assurance Cell Department Wise Action Taken Report on Feedback (2024-25)

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) collected feedback for the academic year 2024–25 from students, teachers, alumni, and employers. The feedback was subsequently categorized and analyzed. IQAC then communicated the observations to all the Heads of Departments of the University and requested recommendations from each department separately for every category of stakeholders.

The major recommendations received from the departments are:

- Upgraded infrastructure with smart classrooms, ICT-enabled teaching tools, improved canteen services, and enhanced sports facilities.
- Strengthened student support through improved hostel facilities, accessible healthcare services and comprehensive placement training programs.
- Emphasized personal skill development in leadership, decision-making, responsibility, and innovative thinking.
- Enhanced professional traits such as punctuality, teamwork, stress management, and workplace commitment.
- Expanded extracurricular and outreach activities to foster holistic learning and community engagement.

Action Taken by IQAC


