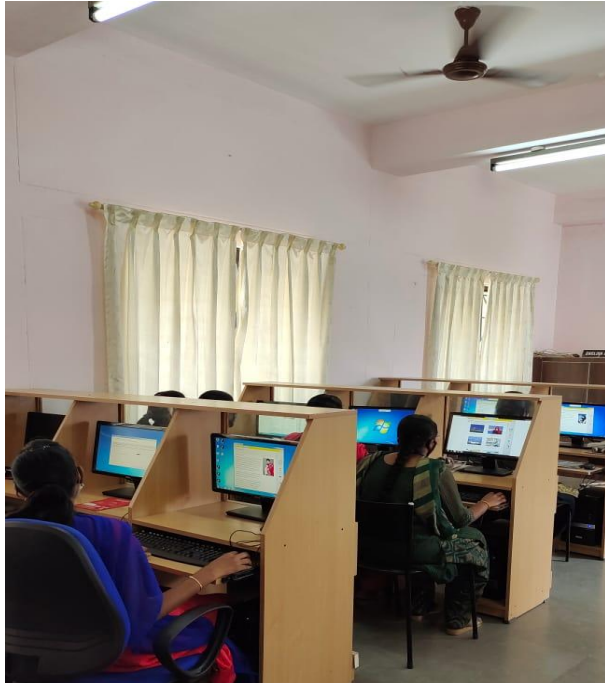

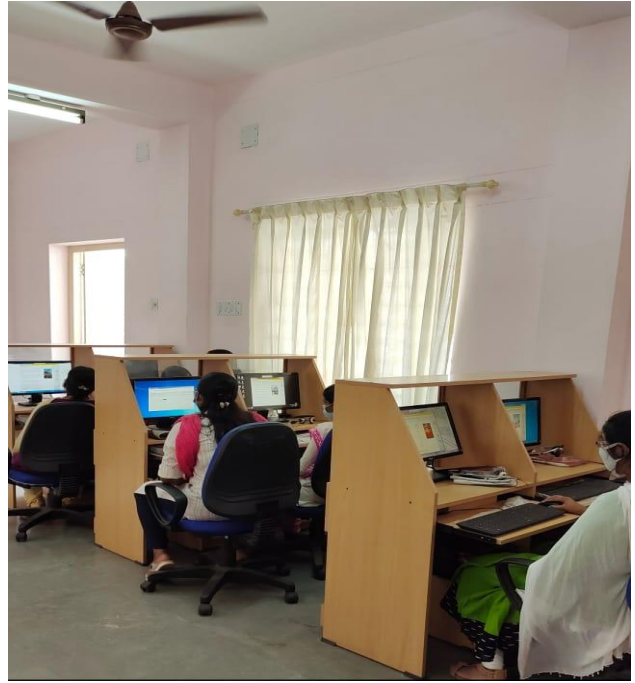

Neuro Linguistic Programming (NLP) helps to expand our response options using its tools and techniques, leading to quick positive responses. The approach and techniques of NLP (John Grinder and Richard Bandler – Founders) are widely used in Behaviour Modifications, Therapy, Sales, Education, Sports, Learning skills, Relationship, Negotiations. We were trained various topic such as, Ego states - Understanding of self and others, Transactions-Relationship building and communication, Games - Conflict resolution, Strokes - Power of motivation, and Script - Power of belief and decision. The second day, we discussed about the understanding NLP techniques such as, Goals and goal setting, Mental maps, Modalities and sub-modalities, Rapport building, Pacing and leading, and Modelling excellence. Finally, the session ended with feedback about the whole session.


