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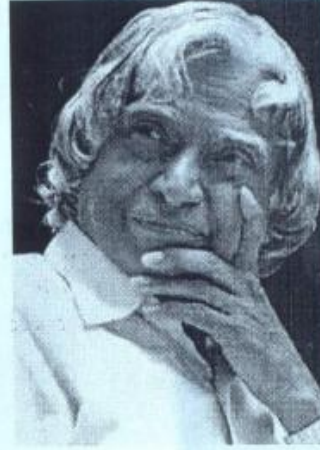

About the Seminar

History is the study of the past, particularly how it relates to humans. It is an umbrella term that relates to past events as well as the memory, discovery, collection, organization, presentation, and interpretation of information about these events. Scholars who write about history are called historians. Events occurring prior to written record are considered prehistory. Sociology is otherwise known as present history of the society. It records the functions of the contemporary social institutions and social process. History is the past sociology and it can also refer to the academic discipline which uses a narrative to examine and analyze a sequence of past events, and objectively determine the patterns of cause and effect that determine them. Historians sometimes debate the nature of history and its usefulness by discussing the

study of the discipline as an end in itself and as a way of providing perspective on the problems of the present. As it is very obvious that only through historical research we can sustain the culture and tradition which help the young people to follow our tradition to have a wonderful nation with over all development.

Sub themes of the Seminar

1. Cultural history (tradition, ideal family, history of women, food, marriage, love and affection, age attaining ceremony, death ceremony, king and kingdoms, education, literature, division of labour in society, and war)
2. Intellectual history (inventions, construction of temples, constructions of dams, construction of monuments, space and astronomy, etc.)
3. Economic History (Agriculture, barter system, trade and commerce, taxation, cottage industries, import-export, Shipping,)
4. Environmental history (agriculture, inventions of agricultural instruments, rivers, forests, hills and mountains, biodiversity, ocean, air, water, land, sun, moon and stars)
5. History of medicine (medicines from plants and animals, medical practice, surgery, healing without medicine, etc.)
6. Military history (war, participation of citizens in war, protection of country, kingdoms, respect on kings, leadership etc.

7. Maritime history (sea, sailing, shipping, dock yards, trade and commerce, invention of new countries, fishing and sea foods, coral reef, pearls etc.)
8. Political history (kingdoms, various tax, conquering the lands, people and valuables, slavery, family politics)
9. Any other relevant topics which fall within the domain of the seminar.
